### **POSITION SUMMARY:**

Under the direction and daily supervision of the Aquatics Director and Summer Program Directors, the Aquatics Staff assists in the operation of the entire Aquatics Program including the pool and the lake.

### **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:**

1. Adheres and complies with the YMCA of High Point Employee Manual, Policy & Procedures Manual, Code of Conduct and Staff Standards & Expectations.
2. Assists in checking equipment and making or requesting repairs.
3. Assists in conducting inventory, storing, and keeping equipment in good condition.
4. During staff training, works with Aquatics Director and Assistant to set up pool and waterfront area and training staff.
5. Assists in the testing and classifying swimming ability of staff and campers.
6. Maintains records on all participants and assists them progress from beginner to advanced levels.
7. Assists with daily inventory and storage of equipment and supplies to ensure adequate quantities.
8. Teaches and monitors proper use of equipment.
9. Assists in maintenance of the pool including vacuuming, cleaning tile, backwashing, etc.
10. Assists in packing all materials and supplies at end of season.
11. Evaluates current season and makes suggestions for following camp season.
12. Monitors chemical and temperature of pool and makes adjustments as needed.
13. Attends all staff meetings, in-service trainings, camp-out/cook out, opening and closing ceremonies as required by supervisors.
14. Conducts behavior at all times in a professional manner to reflect positively on the YMCA.
15. Perform other duties and tasks as requested by immediate supervisor to facilitate efficient and effective operation of the YMCA.

### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

1. Must be at least 16 years of age.
2. Training and experience in waterfront activities.
3. Current water safety instructor's certification.
4. Current lifeguarding, small craft (lake position), and other certifications as appropriate to position.
5. Current CPR and first aid certifications.

### **PHYSICAL DEMANDS**

Sufficient strength, agility and mobility to perform essential functions. Hear noises and distress signals
